The City plans to focus on several valuable yet underutilized structures, including the Historic Tecumseh School Administration building at Shawnee and Ottawa; and is inviting members of the public to contribute to the process.

- ♦ This public meeting is the first step in the Master Plan Amendment process and when a draft plan is prepared the City will hold a Public Hearing prior to Plan adoption, following a 63-day public comment period.
