During public comment, Kristie Miller spoke on behalf of the Miller Consulting and Development Company that is currently invested in the re-imagination of the Tecumseh Products Facility, now known as “Revival Park.” Miller introduced the members of the Revival Park Advisory Committee and says they look forward to partnering with the City of Tecumseh to bring Commerce once again to this part of the community. Miller added that in honor of that endeavor, they intend to ensure that the City reaches its Farmer’s Market initiative by the required deadline.

Bronna Kahle introduced herself and says she is running for State Representative. She wanted to “put a face to the name,” and provide a way to contact her personally if anyone has questions or concerns. Kahle stated that her top priority is to continue the progress of economic growth, business opportunities and job creation. Efficiently caring for seniors, quality education, defending values, and accountability in government are also important issues.

Ron Wimple commented in regards to Tecumseh products, stating that since the announcement was made, he has received a lot of positive responses and the community is looking forward to seeing progress. He added that residents realize it's a process and will take some time.
