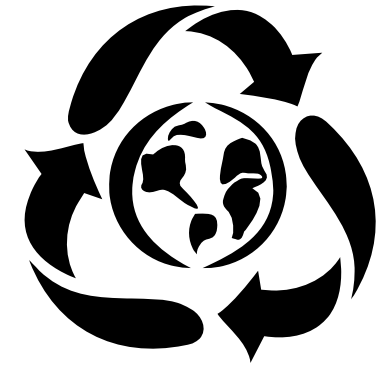

Rural Recycling Program



Two objectives of the Lenawee County Solid Waste Management Plan are:

1. Create an environment conducive to recycling and assist the private and public sectors in instituting recycling programs.
2. Increase recycling by 1% of the total waste stream per year.

To help meet these goals, the LCSW Dept. instituted the **Rural Recycling Program**. The back section of this pamphlet lists the five (5) Rural Recycling locations and seven (7) opportunities paid for by the Lenawee County Solid Waste Dept.

Under an agreement, Allied/Republic Waste Services are hired to provide the recycling services. The following materials are accepted:

- ☺ Newspapers
- ☺ Cardboard
- ☺ Chipboard (cereal boxes / thin cardboard)
- ☺ Clear Glass
- ☺ Tin
- ☺ Plastics #1 and #2
- ☺ Mixed papers (office papers, junk mail, phone books, and magazines, etc.)

Preparing Your Recyclables



GLASS

- Clean and empty
- Remove lid
- NO BROKEN GLASS, window glass or non-container glass



PLASTICS #1 AND #2

- Rinse
- Remove lids and rings
- Crush to save space



CHIPBOARD (cereal box)

- Remove paper/wax paper inserts
- Crush to save space



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

- Crush to save space

Please remove recycling materials from the container you transported them in before placing in the bins. Thank you.



NEWSPAPERS

- Clean and dry
- Remove thin glossies
- Do not bundle with string or rope
- May be placed in paper grocery bags



MIXED PAPERS

- Clean and dry
- Includes office paper, junk mail, phone books, and magazines



TIN AND ALUMINUM

- Remove labels
- No aerosol, paint or solvent containers w/material inside – must be empty (Save for Household Hazardous Waste appointment).
- No aluminum foil, aluminum pie tins or aluminum food trays



STYROFOAM PEANUTS

- Peanut reuse available, see back.
