



PFAS and PFOA **NOT DETECTED** in City Water Samples

On August 2, 2018 the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) sampled the City's water near the supply wells to ensure the City's water sources had not been contaminated with any PFAS or PFOA chemicals. The laboratory results (below) showed NOT DETECTED for all of the PFAS and PFOA constituents.
